pointed by the said recited Act, which, fince the Expiration thereof, are much neglected and a · Nuisance to the Inhabitants, because of some Doubt whether such e new Sewers are within the Jurisdiction of the Laws of Sewers; be it therefore enasted by the Authority aforesaid, That all new Sewers, at any Time since the Twelfth Year of the Reign of the late King Charles the Second, made in any of the said Parishes, shall be henceforth subject to the Commission of Sewers, and to the Laws and Statutes made for Sewers, as fully to all Intents and Purposes, as if fuch Sewers, Sinks and Vaults, had been expressly mentioned in the said Statutes of Sewers, to be under the Survey of the faid Commissioners; and the Commissioners of Sewers, for the Time being, within the Limits of their respective Commissions, shall have Power and Authority, by virtue of this Act, to alter, amend, cleanse, and scour any

any such new Sewers, Sinks, and Vaults, and to order and direct the making of any other new Vaults and Sewers, and to cut into any Drain or Sewer already made, and to alter and take away any Nuisances in the same, and to alter or take away any Cross Gutter or Channels, in all or any of the Streets and Lanes in the Parishes aforesaid.
