



‘ pointed by the said recited Act,  
‘ which, since the Expiration there-  
‘ of, are much neglected and a  
‘ Nuisance to the Inhabitants, be-  
‘ cause of some Doubt whether such  
‘ new Sewers are within the Juris-  
‘ diction of the Laws of Sewers;’  
be it therefore enacted by the  
Authority aforesaid, That all new  
Sewers, at any Time since the  
Twelfth Year of the Reign of the late  
King *Charles* the Second, made in  
any of the said Parishes, shall be  
henceforth subject to the Com-  
mission of Sewers, and to the Laws  
and Statutes made for Sewers, as  
fully to all Intents and Purposes, as  
if such Sewers, Sinks and Vaults,  
had been expressly mentioned in the  
said Statutes of Sewers, to be under  
the Survey of the said Commis-  
sioners; and the Commissioners of  
Sewers, for the Time being, within  
the Limits of their respective Com-  
missions, shall have Power and  
Authority, by virtue of this Act,  
to alter, amend, cleanse, and scour  
any

any such new Sewers, Sinks, and  
Vaults, and to order and direct the  
making of any other new Vaults  
and Sewers, and to cut into any  
Drain or Sewer already made, and  
to alter and take away any Nui-  
sances in the same, and to alter or  
take away any Cross Gutter or  
Channels, in all or any of the Streets  
and Lanes in the Parishes aforesaid.
